- 1. Hammel Woods Project Update:** Scott Randall from WBK will present an update on the dam modification project and timeline. This project is the first of three restoration projects that will be funded with money generated through the special conditions language in NPDES permits. *Scott provided a slide presentation with a recap of the process for investigating alternatives. WBK is in the process of developing final designs and information to be used to assemble the permit package. Draft designs will be shared with the WCFPD and the Coalition in mid-June and permits should be applied for in early July. Over the summer WBK will de-water a portion of the area upstream of the dam to do some structural investigations to assist in developing a bid package for the project. WBK will come back to the Coalition meeting in July with another update. The Coalition will also be deploying one of the older Hach probes in the pool over the summer to collect pre-project data. - 2. Monitoring Program Update:**
  - a. Integrated Prioritization System Model – Stephen McCracken with DRSCW will provide an update and preliminary model runs. This model will assist in identifying and designing the next round of restoration projects. *Stephen provided a slide presentation that explained the components of the updated IPS model, where the data came from, how comparisons were made between the biological data and the stressor conditions and how the information will be used to prioritize and guide restoration in the future. The DRSCW Projects Committee will be reviewing the model runs in more detail at their May 30<sup>th</sup> meeting at Downers Grove SD. The final stressor list will be completed by the end of June and a new draft projects list will be available in late summer.
